I would suggest that you look for hotels located near Kennedy Plaza where the city bus (RIPTA) to the College leaves. For example, #55 and #92. If you are flying to Logan International Airport, Boston you can take the MBTA Silver Line SL 1 to South Street Station where you can embark on a train to Providence. The ride is free from the airport to South Street Station, but you will have to buy a ticket to get back to the airport from South Street.
