I hope this newsletter finds you well. The ISHD conference in Poznań is coming up and for this reason I would like to take this opportunity to share with you some information.

1. ISHD conference as part of the ICHS/CISH conference at Poznań, August 21-27, 2022

Please find information on the four sections of the ISHD at Poznań on our ISHD website (<https://ishd.co/index.php/ishd-conferences/upcoming-conference/>). There are three panels organized by the ISHD and a Joint Session, co-organized by the International Standing Conference for the History of Education (ISCHE) and the ISHD.

The conference is planned in a *hybrid format*. However, speakers and guests who wish to participate online in one or more panels will unfortunately have to pay the same conference fee as those who attend in person (see <https://ichs2020poznan.pl/en/>). This fee is now 150 Euros – and I would like to remind especially the speakers in the four ISHD panels not to forget to pay the fee even if they only participate online. Otherwise, they will not receive online access for their presentation.

2. Invitation to the General Assembly of ISHD members in Poznań (face-to-face)

The General Assembly of ISHD members in Poznań will be held on

Thursday, August 25, 2022, 4-6 p.m.

The venue has not yet been determined by the organizers. Unfortunately, the organizers do not provide for a hybrid format for association meetings, so only members present on site will be able to participate.
